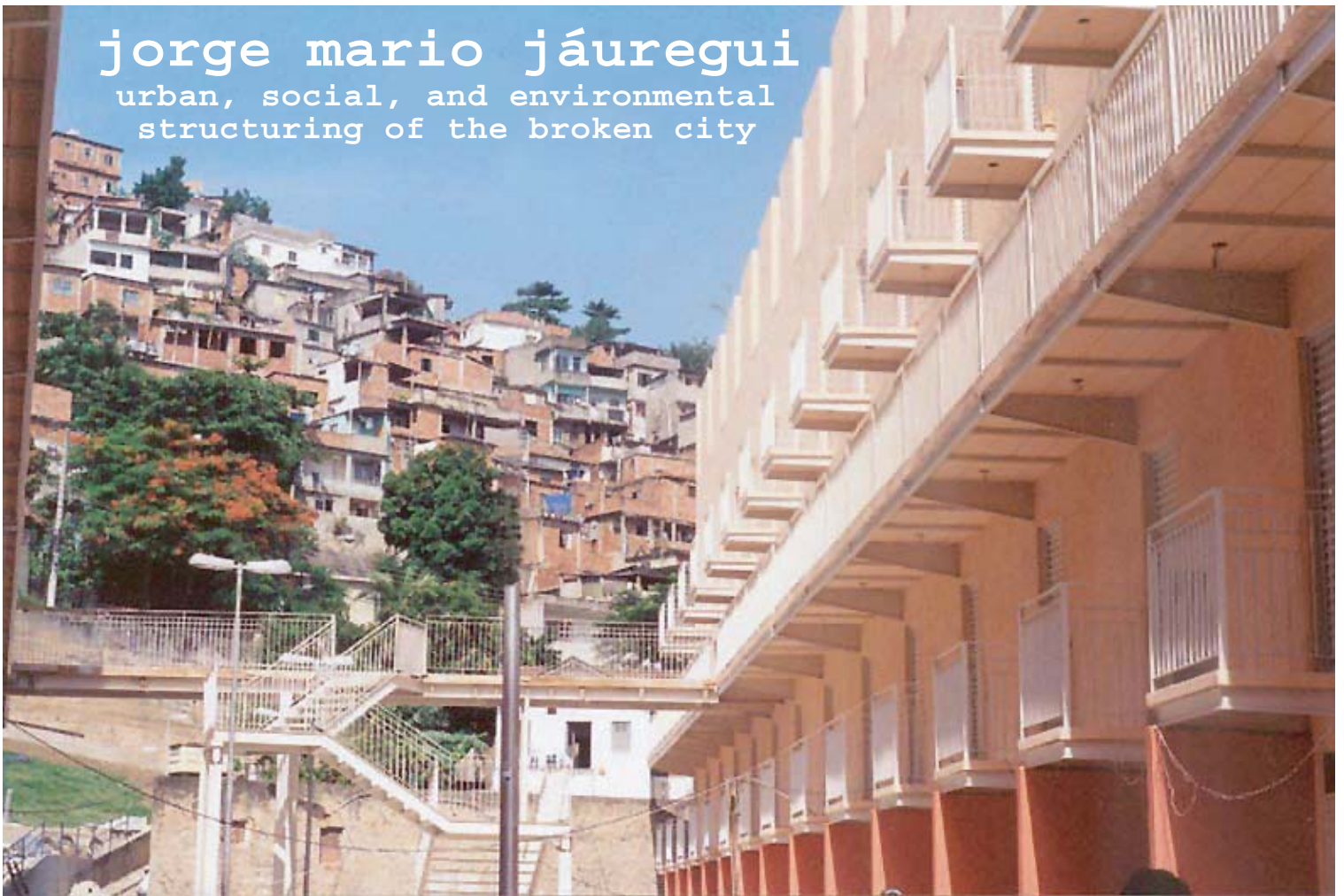

guided by a mission to penetrate and revitalize the shantytowns surrounding rio de janeiro, jáuregui's design initiative ranges from the construction of new streets and pedestrian walkways to community centers. promoting the reorganization of the cores, reading the structure of the place, and by listening to demands, these various projects succeed in improving the sociological and economic status of the community. in 1999 jáuregui was awarded the grand prize at the fourth international architecture biennial in sao paulo. in 2000 he was awarded the sixth veronica rudge green prize in urban design (harvard gsd), published in the book 'the favela-barrio project', 2003.
